

SPIRAL WORKSHOP

The paper spiral provided in the workshop is seen as a symbol or metaphor in relation to cycles and the changing of seasons. The pastels, charcoal and coloured pencils are provided to represent colours in nature on your spiral, and how colours change with the seasons (for both sides of the spiral).

When creating your spiral, engage with the spiral's shape, to creAct a relationship with the river.

When complete, cut out spiral shape, attach string through centre, and carry or hang along the river walk.
